International Award Trip

Last Thursday and Friday, the Bronze International Award participants from Grades 9 and 10 took part in the Bronze International Award training trip to Wadi Sahtan, where they engaged in rich experiential learning alongside their Award Leaders and knowledgeable local guides. Throughout the weekend, students completed three varied hikes through the wadi and surrounding villages, building navigation skills, resilience, and an appreciation for the local environment.

In addition to hiking, students learned essential expedition skills, including safe campsite setup and how to prepare nutritious dinners and breakfasts using camping stoves. Working collaboratively, they set team goals that they will continue to develop and later present to different phases of the school. The trip also provided valuable opportunities to experience and reflect on stages of teamwork, including the "storming" and "norming" phases of Tuckman's model.

The smiles on students' faces and their enthusiastic stories upon return made it clear that the weekend was both enjoyable and impactful. The training trip successfully strengthened teamwork, independence, and confidence as students continue their Bronze International Award journey.






