

Psychology Notices

In psychology this week, grade 9s explored the role of the Hippocampus in memory. As we come to the end of the memory topic, the grade 9s used their developed knowledge of memory to debate the different components in the limbic system. The students used impressive subject knowledge such as the case study of HM and Clive. The students also discussed the multi-store model and critiqued using their own scientific evidence. I am proud of my grade 9 psychology class as they have shown great enthusiasm for the subject and work hard for every lesson.



Project Earthlings: Art Exhibition

A new art exhibition was held at Sultan Qaboos University to celebrate a research collaboration between Cheltenham Muscat, Project Earthlings, and Sultan Qaboos University.

The exhibition, 'Appreciation of Nature and Awareness of its Fragility', featured a collection of students' artwork. They drew inspiration from their first-hand observations of the natural world to create pieces that reflected an appreciation of nature's beauty, structure, and atmosphere. These prints represented the ethos behind Project Earthlings and the sense of environmental responsibility and awareness our pupils hold.

Our students' appreciation and awareness of the environment drove our collaborative research partnership with Sultan Qaboos University. 'Dive into Action: Involving Young Minds in Conservation Research' allowed students to contribute to real-world conservation research, developing their research skills. The projects focused on plastic pollution and the social perceptions of litter.




